LA MERCÈ WITH THE LIVING HERITAGE OF THE CITY

This year's La Mercè highlights the tangible and intangible Catalan cultural heritage recognised by UNESCO with street performances to celebrate the love, respect and pride we feel for our cultural expressions and identity markers, from *castellers* (human towers) to *sardana* gatherings to Gaudí poetry, among others.

As part of the celebration, the Park Güell Plaça de la Natura will be the setting for the **show *Immaterial*, by Cia. Voël** (Saturday 27, 5.30 pm and 7.00 pm), which blends Russian acrobatic circus with references to Catalan cultural heritage elements recognised by UNESCO. We'll be celebrating the **centenary of Antonio González Batista, "El Pescadilla"**, a musician without whom rumba – currently in the process of being recognised as UNESCO heritage – would not be what it is today, in the Plaça de la Catedral (Wednesday 24, 8.00 pm). The company Insectotrópics will present their **travelling show, *El batec de la memòria***, inspired by the symbolic and organic universe of Gaudí, on Passeig de Gràcia (Tuesday 23, 10.00 pm, and Friday 26, 8.30 pm and 11.00 pm) ,and, of course, we will proudly celebrate gatherings of *sardana* dancers and the two traditional *casteller* days.
